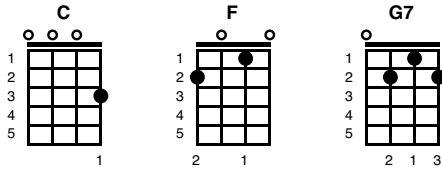


# Ukulele Time
