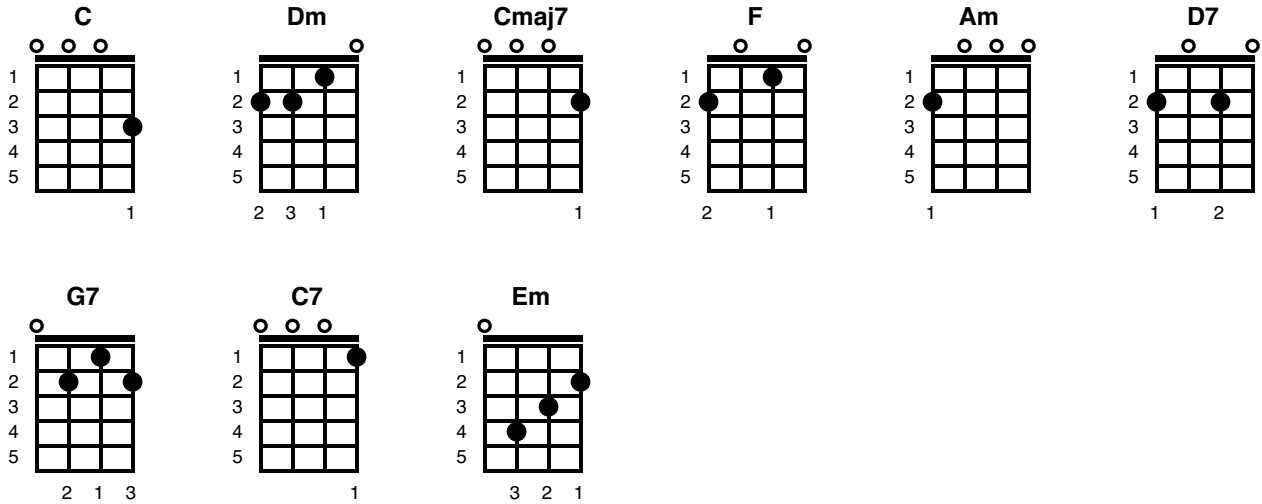


DAYDREAM BELIEVER
