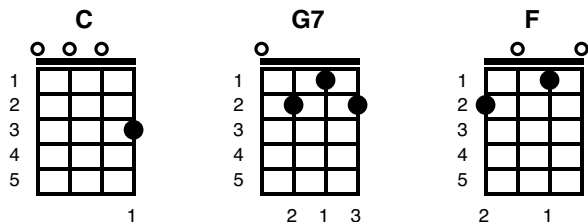


# Beer Beer Beer
