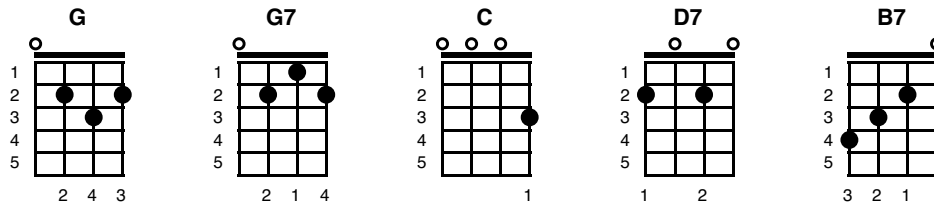


Tennessee Waltz
